## **Green Sheet**

Follow the instructions on the green sheet that came in your ServSafe CFPM exam envelope to check your score and to print your ServSafe CFM Certificate, accessible at <a href="https://www.servsafe.com">www.servsafe.com</a>.

ServSafe requires users to create an account. After doing so, use the ServSafe Session ID (the seven-digit number you wrote on the green sheet of paper that was in your examination envelope), to look up your exam results. If you passed, you will have access to your ServSafe Certificate as a downloadable, printable PDF file.

### WI - CFPM Requirements

The state of Wisconsin does not require state registration, however be sure to post your current ServSafe CFPM certificate in public view.

## **MN – CFPM Requirements**

After you have earned the ServSafe CFPM certificate, the next step is to register your certification with the state and become a state-registered CFPM. Complete the "CFPM Initial Application", accessible at https://www.health.state.mn.us/communities/environment/food/docs/cfpm/cfminitappnew.pdf

- 1. Print your ServSafe CFPM certificate.
- 2. Print and fill out the MN CFPM Initial Application (2-sided).
- 3. Send the application, ServSafe CFM certificate, and \$35 fee to address on the application.
- 4. Now you are **REALLY** certified! You will receive a MN CFPM registration card in the mail.

You MUST submit your ServSafe CFPM certificate to the state of Minnesota within six (6) months of the date of your ServSafe CFPM examination in order to obtain state CFPM registration.

#### **RETESTING**

What if you don't pass? Sometimes a student will miss by a few points. FSG classes are currently around an 85% passing rate. You may retest at any FSG class for \$90. Also know that you may attend any or all of that class in preparation for the retest.

#### **RECERTIFICATION**

And don't forget, plan now for your FoodSafetyGuy recertification in 2 years, 8 months! The state of Minnesota allows registered CFPMs to extend their state registration by completing 4-CEUs every three-years. All FSG classes meet the necessary requirements, including issuing a renewal Certificate for you to submit to the state of Minnesota, which now must be done PRIOR to the current CFPM registration expiration date (no grace period).
